

**Transport conditions for passengers and vehicles**

The carriage of passengers, luggage and vehicles is done in accordance with the present conditions of carriage and according to the Athens Convention and its annexed Protocols or prevailing maritime law.

Passengers are fully responsible for having the required and valid documents for entering another country. Attention is particularly drawn to the regulations laid down within the EU concerning foreign trade, customs, taxes, imports and exports, passport (valid for at least 6 months) visa and health, as well as regulations pertaining to the importation of pets, fresh foodstuffs and other materials. The carrier is entitled - but not under obligation - to check the validity of the required documents.

Weapons, other dangerous items as well as narcotics and other drugs are not allowed on board.

The validity of the travel documents will be examined before departure. For reasons of safety and security, the carrier is entitled to search persons, baggage and vehicles. The carrier reserves the right to refuse carriage to any passenger who refuses this.

For exact check-in-time we refer to the valid timetable.

All fares are valid per person, per bed in the reserved cabin category or per vehicle, unless mentioned otherwise in brochure or timetable. Meals exclusive of drinks/beverages may be included in the fare. Meals not wanted, whether in full or part, are not refunded. Tickets are not transferable and are only valid for the persons to whom they are issued and on the dates stated.

Every passenger is allowed to carry 0.5m<sup>3</sup> hand baggage. For the carriage of baggage in excess of the free baggage allowance the passenger shall pay the current freight rates. All baggage should be tagged with name, address and destination.

The carrier reserves the right to make alterations to the conditions of carriage, the timetable, the prices etc. without previous notice.

Passengers must follow the instructions of the ship's captain and crew.

Travel cancellation insurance is not included in the fare, but we recommend that you take out this insurance. For your own safety's sake, you should also take out luggage insurance, personal travel accident insurance, travel liability insurance and travel health insurance.

The carrier does not accept liability for irregularities such as late or cancelled departures due to technical causes, weather conditions, other outside circumstances or force majeure.

The carrier is not responsible for damage to live animals or to pets brought along by passengers, even if the damage or loss is the result of fault or negligence by the carrier or someone representing the carrier. Live animals must be carried in an approved transportation crate and must have a veterinary certificate. The carriage of animals must be approved by the carrier in advance.
